Min 4560 County Councillors Report

1. Due to the present lack of building development within the ward there have been no 106 monies available to upgrade any facility.
2. There has been a" Safer Routs to School scheme "made available and an application has been sent to Trimsaran school. It is hoped that this scheme would be taken up. The clerk was asked to write to the Headmistress of the school to offer the councils assistance if required to complete the application.
3. It has been brought to my attention that the property at 58 Heol Llanelli has a hedge that protrudes over the boundary wall causing an obstruction not only on the front of the property but also the entrance to the school. The clerk was asked to prepare a letter requesting that the hedge be cut.
4. There have been a number of complaints regarding parking within Garden Suburbs.

5. Due to the recent vandalism at the old dressing room the clerk has been asked to make enquiries in relation to extending the CCTV coverage.
