Min 4775

There were no declarations of interest in respect of the Business to be transacted.

Min 4776

Due to the absence of the Clerk, it was agreed by those in attendance that County Councillor Kim Broom would substitute for the Clerk.

Min 4777

It was agreed to bring forward PcsO and community pathways to start of meeting.

Min 4778

Both PcsO's were welcomed to the meeting.

Discussion around possibility of setting up a community speed watch which is a voluntary service equipment is provided and volunteers are provided with training and support from the police, minimum number of volunteers is three but can be many more , there was a scheme set up in Culla Road but this disbanded after speed bumps were installed. It was agreed to promote and place on TCN page.

There were no major problems in the area at present but it was stressed that incidents should be reported.

The PcsO's were asked to provide some presence in Waun y Clun any morning or afternoon during school drop off to educate and remind parents not to park indiscriminately

They have been liaising with local authorities on the issue around dog fouling to provide joint enforcement patrols.

There is a need to highlight any antisocial behaviour so action can be taken early.

Some action has been taken under section 59 warning motorbike riders at Ffos Las

The PcsO's then thanked the Council for their time and departed the meeting.

Min 4779

Mr Thomas then addressed the meeting regarding Welsh Government funding under Safer Routs in the community, Trimsaran is through the initial round and is being put forward with two other applications from Carmarthenshire, the aim is to provide safer walking and cycling routs to school and within the community.

The consultation is now live and as many people from the community as possible are invited to give their opinion on what is required, mindful of cost implications.

Significant discussion then took place on the proposal that are currently recommended

And it was felt that this would make a significant improvement to the village.

Mr Thomas was asked what chance was there to obtain the grant ,his response was that last year three applications were put forward and that two were awarded, this is the last year that funding is available and that the amount available would be less.

It was agreed to promote consultation and members will bring up in other groups to provide feedback and engagement. Comments by Christmas via email to
