## Min 5617

# **Min 5618 Matters Arising**

# **Min 5621 County Councillors Report**

- 1. General housing issues, potholes and litter bins being an issue this month.
- 2. Void properties some have been placed
- 3. Tender from the SPF grant starting next week some time, plant some trees grant will be finished some signs are required to be completed around the park, need authority from councillors to give go a head go ahead given.
- 4. Both Skate Park ramps need removal due to condition, need to think with what we replace them with, will need to ask community what they would like with constraints with the cost of replacement.
- 5. All County Councils in Wales have issues around budget over spend.
- 6. Standstill budget 5% without any pay awards, with significant cut.

# Min 5622 7(a) Planning

# Min 5623 7(b)

Pre-Application Consultation for the following development – Residential Development. On Land at Gwelfor, Heol Llanelli, Trimsaran, SA17 4AG

Firstly, Trimsaran Community council would welcome the development of bungalows in the village, but in the discussion on the above development Trimsaran Community Council noted the following concerns.

- 1. Concern with the access point to the development, specifically visibility splay.
- 2. Known Knotweed on the development which has been brought into the site with earlier groundworks.
- 3. Drainage issues historically and currently at the location.
- 4. Objection to the removal of the Oak tree (Sessile Oak) in the middle of the development.
- 5. Do not accept the offsite compensation area as acceptable as it is a current habitation site, does not compensate for the removal of existing.
- 6. Concern regarding public transport, this is a limited service (bus every two hours during main part of day) not suitable for early morning start or evening, not available on Bank Holidays or Sundays.

- 7. Concern with wording of local convenience shops. (there is only one) Also the social club and workingman's club are not operational.
- 8. To reach the National cycle route 4, running through countryside near Pinged is a dangerous route to cycle to and from Trimsaran.
- 9. Ecological Services Habitat Management Plan page 7 2.5) The Guidelines for the Selection of Wildlife Sites in South Wales by The South Wales Wildlife Partnership provides a, criteria, for a site to be considered a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation (SINC) based on the habitats and species present. The table within Appendix 1 details which species are present within the development site that are considered indicator species of SINC quality marshy grassland habitat. 13 indicator species were present during the July 2024 site visit. At least 12 indicator species need to be present for marshy grassland to be considered species rich and SINC quality habitat. The marshy grassland within the development site is considered to qualify as SINC habitat.
- 10. Given noncompliance of speed with vehicles, in that area, consideration should be given to placing cables to monitor speed and size of vehicles, prior to any development, to determine if further mitigation is needed near the entrance.
- 11. It was resolved that if planning minded passing the application, then Trimsaran Community Council would like 106 mitigation contribution towards park improvement and maintenance of the green areas within Trimsaran and contribution to restore and maintain the Miners Welfare Hall.

Clerk instructed to respond to Evans Bank of the above concerns to the development.
